CSA 2010 is a pro-active initiative to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of FMCSA's enforcement and compliance program to achieve the Agency's mission to reduce commercial motor vehicle (CMV) crashes, fatalities, and injuries.

What You Will Learn

- Proposed change would:
 - Incorporate on-road safety performance via new SMS on a monthly basis.
 - Continue to include major safety violations found as part of CSA 2010 investigations.
 - Produce a Safety Fitness Determination of:
 - Unfit
 - Marginal
 - Continue Operation
- The 7 behavior analysis and safety improvement categories (basics).
- The way FMCSA will conduct audits or reviews.
- The new intervention tools
 - Warning letters
 - Investigations
 - Corrective actions

Driver Safety Measurement System (DSMS)

- Driver profiles will be made available through FMCSA's Commercial Driver (PSP) through a third party vendor.
- May result in notice of violation or claim based on driver history across current and previous employers.
